Old Langham Farm, Lodsworth As you enter Lodsworth from the A272 the garden is the third house on the left. *Sue Loughnan has created the most wonderful walled garden with a wide variety of trees, shrubs, flowers and vegetables. Her Wisley sweet peas, the rambling roses and many unusual plants are special memories of a recent visit, but there is much, much more to see.*

Farthings, Kirdford Coming from Petworth towards Kirdford, take a left turn signposted Northchapel approx 1/2 a mile before reaching Kirdford. Farthings is the first house on the left. The illustrated picture of Farthings in the garden leaflet does not do it justice! Charles and Karen Sommer have created a beautiful garden with 2 or 3 herbaceous borders bursting with colour. They have a magnificent orange coloured rose as you enter the gates with swathes of love-in-the-mist, delphiniums, and other perennials, with striking views to the south downs.
